1. Parties

This Membership Agreement and Liability Waiver ("Agreement") is entered into between:

2. Enrollment and Program Selection

Individual results depend on the Member's effort, aptitude, practice, and consistency of attendance.

3. Acceptance of Governing Documents

By signing this Agreement, the Member (or Guardian) confirms that they have received, read, and understood the following documents, and agrees to be bound by their terms:

1. The Panipat Chess Club Charter and Constitution (PC-GOV-001).
2. The Panipat Chess Bylaws (PC-GOV-002).
3. The Panipat Chess Privacy Policy (PC-LEG-002).
4. This Membership Agreement and Liability Waiver (PC-LEG-001).

4. Fees and Payment

4.1 The Member agrees to pay the applicable program fees in full before the commencement of the first class in the enrolled Program Cycle.

4.2 All payments are made to Tensai Ventures LLC through the Club's approved payment channels.

4.3 Refund Policy. The Member may request a full refund within 48 hours of completing payment. After this 48-hour window, no refunds will be issued for the current Program Cycle. If the Member fails to attend a scheduled class without providing at least 24 hours' prior notice, the class shall be counted as attended, and no make-up class or refund will be provided.

5. Assumption of Risk

5.1 The Member (or Guardian) acknowledges that participation in chess classes and competitive events, whether conducted in person at the Club's operating address or online, involves certain inherent risks. While chess is primarily a mental activity and physical risks are minimal, participation may involve sustained periods of concentration, exposure to competitive stress, and, in the case of in-person attendance, the general risks associated with travel to and presence at the Club's facility.

5.2 The Member (or Guardian) knowingly, freely, and voluntarily assumes all risks associated with participation in Club activities, including but not limited to any injury, illness, property damage, or loss that may result, directly or indirectly, from such participation.

6. Liability Waiver and Release

6.1 To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, the Member (or Guardian, on behalf of the Member and the Member's heirs, next of kin, and legal representatives) hereby waives and releases Panipat Chess, Tensai Ventures LLC, and their respective directors, officers, managers, members, agents, employees, and affiliates (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any and all liability, claims, demands, actions, causes of action, costs, and expenses of any kind, whether known or unknown, whether foreseen or unforeseeable, arising from or related to the Member's participation in Club activities.

6.2 This waiver and release includes, without limitation, claims arising from the negligence of the Released Parties (excluding gross negligence or willful misconduct), and claims related to personal injury, property damage, emotional distress, or financial loss.

6.3 The Member (or Guardian) agrees not to initiate any legal proceedings against any of the Released Parties on the basis of the claims waived and released herein.

7. Medical Acknowledgment

7.1 The Member (or Guardian) represents that the Member is in good physical and mental health and is capable of participating in the enrolled program. The Member (or Guardian) is solely responsible for evaluating the Member's fitness to participate and for consulting a medical professional if there are any concerns.

7.2 Panipat Chess has not made any representations or warranties regarding the Member's ability to participate. The Club is not responsible for any adverse health effects that may arise from participation.

7.3 In the event of a medical emergency during a Club activity, the Member (or Guardian) authorizes the Club to arrange for emergency medical treatment at the Member's (or Guardian's) expense.

8. Media and Recording Consent

8.1 The Member (or Guardian) consents to Panipat Chess recording, photographing, or otherwise capturing the Member's image, voice, and likeness during Club activities, whether online or in person.

8.2 The Member (or Guardian) grants Panipat Chess and Tensai Ventures LLC a perpetual, royalty-free, worldwide license to use such recordings and images for educational, promotional, and archival purposes, including but not limited to use on the Club's website, social media channels, and marketing materials.

8.3 The Member (or Guardian) acknowledges that they will not receive compensation for such use and waives any claims related to the use of their image or likeness, including claims of defamation, invasion of privacy, or right of publicity.

9. Intellectual Property

The Member acknowledges that all instructional materials, curricula, lesson plans, training exercises, and other content provided by Panipat Chess are the intellectual property of Tensai Ventures LLC. The Member shall not reproduce, distribute, sell, record, or otherwise transfer any Club materials without the prior written consent of the Director.

10. Confidentiality

The Member agrees to keep confidential any proprietary training methods, strategies, or materials shared during Club activities. This obligation survives the termination of membership.

11. Indemnification

The Member (or Guardian) agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Released Parties from and against any and all claims, damages, losses, costs, and expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees) arising from or related to: (a) the Member's breach of this Agreement; (b) the Member's violation of the Club's Code of Conduct; or (c) any act or omission of the Member during Club activities that causes harm to another person or their property.

12. Governing Law and Dispute Resolution

12.1 This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Wyoming, United States of America, without regard to its conflict of laws principles.

12.2 Any dispute arising out of or relating to this Agreement shall first be submitted to good-faith mediation. If mediation is unsuccessful, the dispute shall be resolved by binding arbitration in Sheridan County, Wyoming, in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association.

12.3 The prevailing party in any arbitration or legal proceeding shall be entitled to recover reasonable attorneys' fees and costs from the non-prevailing party.

13. Severability

If any provision of this Agreement is found to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect. The

invalid provision shall be modified to the minimum extent necessary to make it valid and enforceable.

14. Entire Agreement

This Agreement, together with the Club Charter, Bylaws, and Privacy Policy, constitutes the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior or contemporaneous understandings, agreements, or representations, whether written or oral.

15. Affirmation and Signatures
